## Launching a Crowdfunding Project

Here are instructions on how your family can set up its own crowdfunding page to help take the gospel to the unreached! This is a great way to spur others on to help. It can also let your family track just how much you've raised from others. Create a page, give your donations to it, and then use Facebook and email to ask family and friends to join you.

### Instructions:

1. Make sure you have a photo of yourself or your family. Snap one on your phone right now.
2. Go to <https://p2p.idonate.com/pioneers> to see all five projects we've learned about.
3. Choose the project you want to promote from THUMB, click on the project, and then click "Become a Fundraiser." Then create a login, use a Facebook preferably.
4. Once you are in, you want to select the option to create a "New Team." Then you will be asked to do the following:
  - a. Type up a Team Name, maybe something like maybe "The Johns Family."
  - b. Choose a Fundraiser Title, like "Help the Tarahumara."
  - c. Then set a Fundraiser Goal. Maybe consider doubling what you have to give. For example, if you and your family are giving \$250, then set a goal of \$500 and pray that God would double your giving through friends and family.
  - d. Finally, set the Fundraiser End Date for November 17.
5. After you complete that section, you will move on to another section where you will need to:
  - a. Upload your photo. Maybe use a family photo or a photo of your Generous Jar.
  - b. Then enter a quick summary of your team's fundraiser description:
    - Tell everyone who your team is
    - Explain that you've been learning about world views
    - Tell people how your donations help. Here is a summary:
      - \$25 provides a water filter to the Tribal Tarahumara
      - \$13 provides a week of HIV medication to Hindu Indians
      - \$7 provides 10 evangelistic booklets for Hungarian kids
      - \$17 provides a food package for a Muslim refugee family
      - \$5 provides a Bible for a Buddhist in Myanmar
6. Finally, you can start sharing with your family and friends!
  - a. You can edit a quick email and send it to family or friends.
  - b. Even better if you can share via Facebook.
7. Once you've finished, go to visit your new Team Page and donate! Now you have your own page that you can use for raising funds, tracking everything your family helps raise from others!
